Grade Level and Subject (of this example): 6-8

Topic/Content Standards (for this example):

Social Studies - understanding map projections, geographic/political/demographic data, identifying countries.



Summary of Project:

Students in a 6th grade social studies class drew and assembled paper globes that showed geographic, political or demographic information by country. They used paper and art materials to draw flat maps first, then cut and formed their maps into globes. Through this project, students learned about map projections and had to research their assigned statistics.
