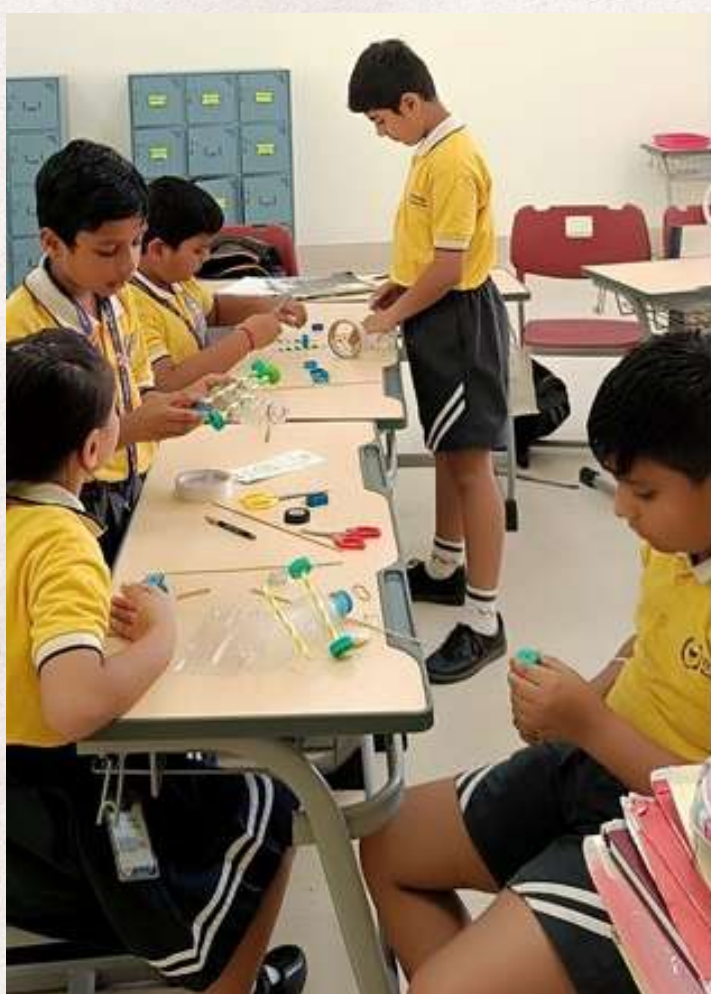

HOUSE LAUNCH

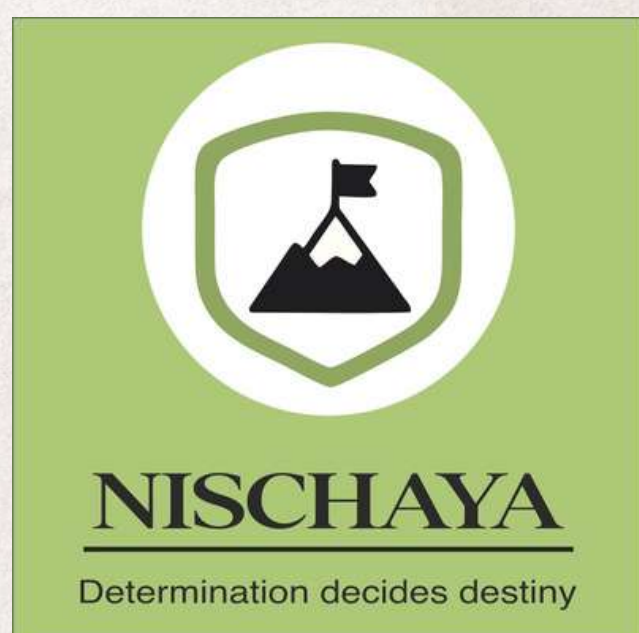
This month, our school's spirit soared as four vibrant houses emerged, igniting camaraderie, rivalry, and pride.

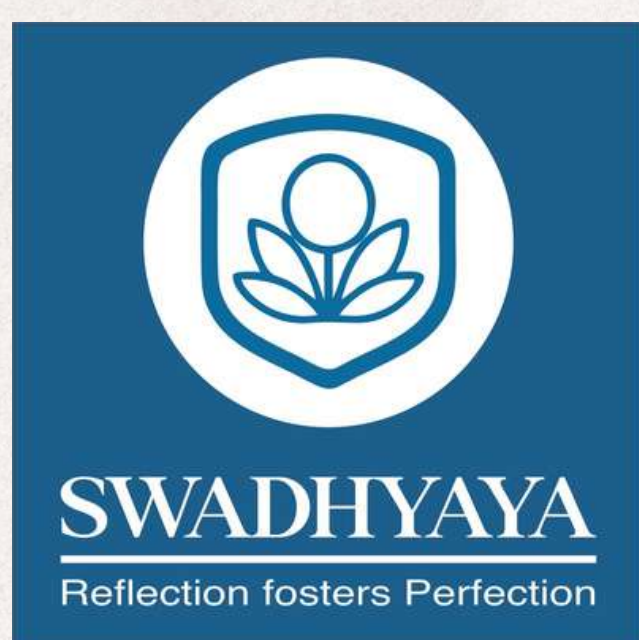
