### EKTA DIWAS: UNITY BUILT ON HONEST VALUES

### October 31, 2025

On National Unity Day, our young learners explored the life and legacy of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, the Iron Man of India. Through stories and discussions, they understood that unity isn't just about being together, it's about standing together with **honesty, courage**, and mutual respect.

The children discovered that Ekta, unity begins in small moments: sharing with a friend, helping a classmate, standing up for what's right. They learned that just as Sardar Patel unified our nation through courage and conviction, they too can create unity through their daily actions and choices.

This understanding reflects **growth**, the ability to connect our individual actions to the larger collective good. It builds **self-worth**, knowing that each of us, no matter how young or small, has a role to play in creating harmony.

#### What had happened?

For two days, this child had watched her friends and classmates take the stage. She had witnessed their courage, their joy, their fearless expression. And something inside her awakened. She didn't overthink it. She didn't wait for permission or preparation.

She simply decided: "I can do this too".

This is the essence of fearless education at Vivitsa. It's not about perfect performances or flawless students. It's about creating an environment where children feel safe enough to say, "I want to try," and brave enough to do it even without preparation, even with uncertainty.

Because at Vivitsa, fearless education doesn't mean being without fear. It means learning to move forward despite it.
