

## Responsibilities?



- Interns will...

  - Additional opportunities to develop skills in community engagement, social media, and Non-Profit Management, depending on your interests!
  - Work closely with the ASC Intern Coordinator to identify skills and goals you want to achieve through the internship

  - But, summer events will run from Aspen to Silt




# What does a typical week




# look like?

**Students who:**


- have a strong interest in STEM subjects and are eager to learn more

- Available to attend 2 days of intern training and orientation prior to the start of the internship, ideally June 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>









Junior Intern Educator	9th and 10th grade students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Entry-level position</li> <li>• Opportunity to gain skills and experience to return as an Intern Educator in future summers.</li> <li>• Paid a stipend</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1-3 weeks of assistant-teaching a camp</li> <li>• Additional opportunities to assist with other programs as available and interested.</li> </ul>
Intern Educator	11th-12th grade & college-age students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• May lead-teach some activities in the Camps as comfortable</li> <li>• Paid hourly \$15-\$17/hour</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 20-40 hours / week</li> <li>• Work available up to the full 10 weeks of summer</li> </ul>
Lead Intern Educator	College-age students motivated to take on a greater leadership role	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Additional leadership responsibilities and opportunities to the Regular Internship</li> <li>• Must have access to a car and a valid driver's license to transport program materials</li> <li>• Will be the lead ASC staff working at the Community Markets</li> <li>• Paid hourly \$20-\$22/hour</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 30-40 hours / week</li> <li>• Work available up to the full 10 weeks of summer</li> </ul>



# Commitment and Compensation



## **Time Commitment**

Hours will vary each week depending on your availability but will likely range from 20 - 40 hours with some weekend and evening hours required. Summer programming runs from June 8<sup>th</sup> to August 14<sup>th</sup>. Intern Educators will be scheduled to work full or partial days from 8:00am - 4:00pm



## **Training and Orientation**

Available to attend training prior to the start of internship work. Ideally June 4<sup>th</sup> and June 5<sup>th</sup>



## **Paid!!**

Interns Educators will be compensated based on their internship level and prior experience. Milage will be reimbursed for travel to/from program site. Mileage is not reimbursed for travel to/from the ASC office for training/non - program delivery. If using public transportation, bus passes can be provided


