King County Housing Authority (KCHA) is one of the largest housing authorities in the state of Washington, with a mission to provide safe, affordable housing to more than 50,000 people.

Managing over 90 properties with a small team was challenging, especially with regular issues like theft and break-ins. Something needed to change for KCHA.

REPLACING BLIND SPOTS WITH REAL DETERRENCE

KCHA faced offline cameras and thin guard coverage until an armed threat at one of its offices became the tipping point. Since deploying LVT, KCHA has helped apprehend a violent-crime suspect, driven incident counts down by 33%, and zero burglaries at its offices since 2023, proving that a small security team with the right technology can operate and protect at scale.
