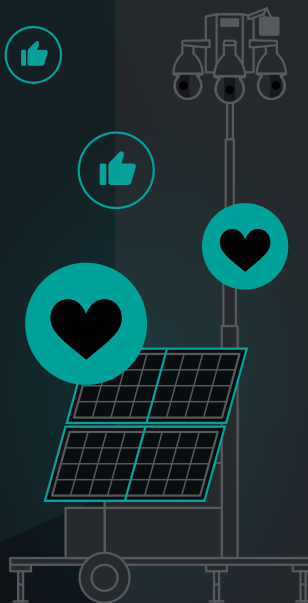

Safer Stores, Stronger Communities: **THE IMPACT OF LVT IN DETROIT**

ACCESS 2.0 deployed to Detroit, Michigan in November 2024. LVT Units were deployed to retailers and restaurants throughout the city. The Loss Prevention Research Council (LPRC) conducted a survey of participants and community members. Almost 200 people responded. Here's what the survey found:

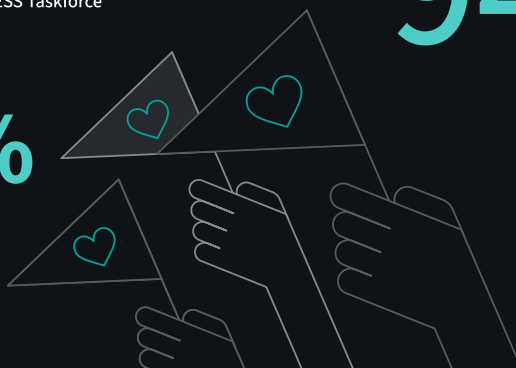
