Trentino, 2020 — Ripe plum fruit layered over a faintly grassy background note. Dry, soft and well-balanced. Pleasing bitter twist in the finish. Cabernet Sauvignon, Carmenère & Merlot blend.

**Cembra Schiava Vigneti Delle Dolomiti DOC** 80

Trentino, 2023 — Light red, fresh red forest fruits, slightly acidic, soft and balanced.

**Fabiano 'Amarone della Valpolicella' Classico DOCG** 205

Veneto, 2022 — Amarone 'Storica' characterised by an intense ruby color. Vanilla, cherry, plum and coffee. Full, warm and velvety. Corvina, Veronese & Rondinella.

**Pio Cesare DOCG 'Barolo'** 285

Piedmont, 2016 — An amazing wine but not quite at the level of the 2019. Soft tannins, balanced fruit, excellent structure, harmony and elegance. Nebbiolo.

**Pio Cesare DOCG 'Barolo'** 450

Piedmont, 2019 — WOW. Spicy red cherries, savoury forest, walnut shell. Full-bodied with very fine, firm, silky tannins. Focused fruit and spice. Nebbiolo.

**Pio Cesare DOCG 'Mosconi Barolo'** 500

Piedmont, 2019 — Dried red berries, truffle hints, dried flowers. Full-bodied with a fine-tannin framework, needs time to open up. Open the bottle and drink something else while you wait. Nebbiolo.

### Central Italy

**Vinetti de Fiorini DOCG 'Chianti Superiore'** 66

Tuscany, 2021 — Juicy cherry and cranberry notes mingle with licorice, cloves and pepper. Aged in oak barrels. Sangiovese, Canaiolo, Ciliegiole & Cabernet Sauv blend.

**Tolaini Rosso 'Legit'** 130

Tuscany, 2018 — Hints of green pepper, licorice and graphite melted with oak vanilla flavours. Full bodied with a ripe fruit palate. Cabernet Sauvignon.

Tuscany, 2020 — Dried roses, wild mushrooms, sour cherries, raspberries, olives and spices. Medium-bodied tannin frame and a creamy core of red fruit. Sangiovese, Canaiolo & Syrah.

**Pasetti Montepulciano D'Abruzzo** 100

Abruzzo, 2021 — Sour berries, currant and blackberries, with hints of licorice, cinnamon and black pepper. Soft, elegant and mature tannins. Montepulciano.

**La Valentina 'Spelt' DOC** 125

Abruzzo, 2019 — Rich, ripe red fruit flavours, tannins and fresh acidity are softened by barrique and bottle maturation. Montepulciano.

**Col d'Orcia 'Brunello di Montalcino' DOCG** 250

Tuscany, 2018 — Intense, broad and complex. Hints of cherry, blackberry with vanilla and woody notes from the oak. Full-bodied wine, excellent structure, strong and balanced. Soft, ripe tannins. Sangiovese.

**Donnafugata 'Sherazade' DOC** 95

Sicily, 2022 — Bright ruby red colour with violet reflections. Fruity bouquet with plum and cherry, delicate black pepper and violet notes. Nero d'Avola.

**Donnafugata 'Tancredi'** 195

Sicily, 2020 — Intense ruby red colour. Notes of plums and blueberries, with delicate spicy hints of liquorice and sweet tobacco. Cabernet Sauvignon, Nero d'Avola & Tannat.

Puglia IGT, 2021 — Deep ruby red with violet reflections. Notes of plum, cherry, rosemary, vanilla and peppery spice. A well balanced, full finish. Zinfandel.

Martinborough, 2019 — This Special Cuvee is only made in the best of years and only from the best barrels produced that year. Each vintage is named after members of the Leung family. The 2019 Two Lawyers is a tribute to Edward and Marjory Leung's daughter and son-in-law. It is a made up of a field blend of 5 clones which were co-fermented and some Abel for structure.

**Donnafugata 'Ben Rye' DOC** 20 / 145

Sicily, 2021 — Golden amber, apricot, yellow peach, candied orange peel, mango and papaya, herbs, honey. Zibibbo. Its like drinking liquid semidried apricots. 75ml pour via Coravin @ 20

**Tonelli Corrado Visner Vino e Visciole** 10 / 89

Le Marche, NV — Dense and rich. Like Christmas in a bottle. Visner is made by macerating wild sour cherries (*Prunus Cerasus*) in Rosso Piceno red wine (a 50/50 blend of Sangiovese and Montepulciano) from the previous vintage with the addition of sugar and a small percentage of crushed cherry kernels. The mixture referments and is then filtered and bottled. 75ml pour via Coravin @ 10

*Amaro (meaning bitter in Italian) is an Italian herbal liqueur made by macerating barks, roots, citrus peels, and other botanicals in high-strength alcohol; once the desired aroma is achieved, the juice is aged in barrel or bottle before adding sugar and water to achieve the desired bittersweet profile and alcoholic strength.*

*Originally these were often made by Monks and used as cures for most ailments, including everything from aches and pains to cholera.*

*We have a selection of Amaro at Reggie's - ranging from light/floral/sweet, to dark/bitter/herbal and are perfect after a meal to aid in digestion.*

## Fernet Branca 10 / 125

**Served at the bartenders discession.**

Milan, Italy — Fernet Branca's exact recipe is a secret, but they say it's made using 27 different herbs and spices from four different countries. From what we know, they use aloe, gentian root, and red cinchona bark. Bitter, herbaceous, medicinal and root-y like black licorice. A team favourite.

## Bergia Rabarbaro 8 / 90

Turin, Italy, 16% — Made since 1870, It takes 12 long months and a very complex production process to obtain Rabarbaro Bergia. After a long slow maceration of the rhubarbs, it's then blended with sugar and botanicals. Sweet balsamic, then intense rhubarb.

## Montenegro 9 / 100

Bologna, Italy, 23% — Lightly sweet with rose petals, dried orange peel, and cherry. A subtle earthy spice of cassia bark, allspice, coriander, and saffron as well as black tea and tobacco. The bitterness is soft and elegant.

## Averna 10 / 120

Sicily, Italy, 29% — Made since 1868, A classic amaro utilising Mediterranean herbs and roots, plus pomegranate and bitter orange. Averna is sweet, thick and has gentle herbal bitterness.

## Saison Marigold 14 / 168

Melbourne, AUS, 22% — Made in Melbourne by chef / vermouth guy Dave Verheul, this wine-based amaro focuses on summer marigolds. Made with different varieties of marigolds, venus apricots, coriander seeds, smoked white grapefruit skin, and burnt blood orange. It's rich and flavoursome, with a lovely black tea-like edge and warming finish.
