Sicily, 2021 — Golden amber, apricot, yellow peach, candied orange peel, mango and papaya, herbs, honey, Zibibbo. Its like drinking liquid semidried apricots.

Tonelli Corrado Visner Vino e Visciole 10 / 89

Le Marche, NV — Dense and rich. Like Christmas in a bottle. Visner is made by macerating wild sour cherries (*Prunus Cerasus*) in Rosso Piceno red wine (a 50/50 blend of Sangiovese and Montepulciano) from the previous vintage with the addition of sugar and a small percentage of crushed cherry kernels. The mixture referments and is then filtered and bottled.

Amaro (meaning bitter in Italian) is an Italian herbal liqueur made by macerating barks, roots, citrus peels, and other botanicals in high-strength alcohol; once the desired aroma is achieved, the juice is aged in barrel or bottle before adding sugar and water to achieve the desired bitter-sweet profile and alcoholic strength. Originally these were often made by Monks and used as cures for most ailments, including everything from aches and pains to cholera.

Milan, Italy — Fernet Branca's exact recipe is a secret, but they say it's made using 27 different herbs and spices from four different countries. From what we know, they use aloe, gentian root, and red cinchona bark. Bitter, herbaceous, medicinal and root-y like black licorice. A Reggie's favourite.

Bergia Rabarbaro

8 / 90

Turin, Italy, 16% — Made since 1870, It takes 12 months and a very complex production process to obtain Rabarbaro Bergia. After a long slow maceration of the rhubarbs, it's then blended with sugar and botanicals. Sweet balsamic, then intense rhubarb.

Montenegro

9 / 100

Bologna, Italy, 23% — Lightly sweet with rose petals, dried orange peel & cherry. A subtle earthy spice of cassia bark, allspice, coriander, and saffron as well as black tea and tobacco. The bitterness is soft and elegant.

Averna

Sicily, Italy, 29% — Made since 1868, A classic amaro utilising Mediterranean herbs and roots, plus pomegranate and bitter orange. Averna is sweet, thick and has gentle herbal bitterness.

Saison Marigold

Melbourne, AUS, 22% — Made in Melbourne by chef / vermouth guy Dave Verheul, this wine-based amaro focuses on summer marigolds. Made with different varieties of marigolds, venus apricots, coriander seeds, smoked white grapefruit skin, and burnt blood orange.
