


THE POP COURT

The POP Tennis court is flexible and can be set up in a variety of layouts on a variety of surfaces. A traditional tennis court can be used to create up to two POP Tennis courts.

POP COURT DIMENSIONS

POP RULES

POP Tennis is played and scored by the same rules as traditional tennis, with some small differences.

SERVING

- The server is allowed only one serve per point
- That serve must be an underarm serve
- The server serves from the baseline, alternating between deuce court and ad court (right and left)
- The serve must land in the diagonally opposite service box
- Player must serve from behind the baseline

SCORING

- Just like traditional tennis, you can play tiebreak sets, with advantage scoring within each game
- e.g. 15, 30, 40, Ad-Game

EQUIPMENT

Low Compression Balls

50% and 75% the compression of a normal tennis ball for lower bounces and longer rallies.

POP Tennis paddle


The solid, round paddle is shorter than a tennis racquet, made from carbon fibre or fibreglass, with holes and a textured face for added control.

A POP Tennis court is easy to set up and can be played anywhere, anytime by anyone!


