Hazard Type Info

Disaster AWARE's biomedical hazard type provides users real-time global monitoring and situational intelligence to better understand and respond to biomedical events, such as CDC travel notices, US State Dept advisories, Risk and Vulnerability scores by country/region assessing resiliency to respond to biomedical outbreaks, and more. Know what assets & employees may be impacted, as well as the general exposure within the hazard zone (population, households, economic value, etc).



Focused Alerting

View and keep tabs on global Biomedical activity or define SmartAlert areas to receive Smart Alerts only for the places you care about.

Enhance the monitoring and protection of specific assets (e.g. buildings, team and resource locations)

Issued for single or multi-country events:

High morbidity and mortality. Substantial public health consequences requiring an international response. Take immediate action.



Watch

Moderate public health consequences. Deterioration of local response capacity and weakening of health system.


Advisory

Cautionary phase. An event potentially requiring a response has occurred. Unlikely to require immediate action.



Information


Preparatory phase. Event is being monitored by authorities. No immediate response.









Quickly assess the event/ impact and view related GIS layers




CDC Travel Notices (Hazard Tooltip)




