LPN ELIGIBILITY FOR FOOT CARE CLINICALS WITH FOOT CANADA TRAINING:

Licensed Practical Nurses (LPNs) practicing foot care in Alberta must first complete an approved Basic Foot Care education program before participating in any clinical training or clinical practicums in the community.

This requirement aligns with guidance from the College of LPNs and Health Care Aides of Alberta (CLHA), *formerly* the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Alberta (CLPNA). Foundational education ensures LPNs have the competencies required for safe foot care practice, including infection prevention and control, diabetic risk assessment, and lower limb screening.

At this time, Foot Canada Training is not yet recognized as an approved foundational Basic Foot Care program for LPNs in Alberta. As a result, Nursing Soles Inc. cannot currently provide advanced clinical practicums to LPNs who have not completed an approved foundational program.
