The **Festival Interceltique de Lorient** is a major annual Celtic festival held in Lorient, Brittany, France. The event was founded in 1971 by Polig Monjarret and takes place every August, showcasing the cultural traditions of the Celtic nations through music, dance, art, and other performances. The festival features various events throughout the city, including those at the Palais des Congrès, Grand Théâtre, andglise Saint Louis, as well as larger gatherings at the Parc du Moustoir, Port de Pêche, and other locations. The festival kicks off with a traditional Breton seafood dinner called Cotriade or Kaoteriad, accompanied by sea shanties and marine music in the Port de Pêche harbour district. On Sunday morning, over 3,500 musicians, singers, and dancers from Celtic nations parade through the city streets in national costumes for the Grand Parade of Celtic Nations. The National Bagado Championship finals take place at Parc de Moustoir during the first weekend. Individual piping competitions and celtic wrestling tournaments with representatives from various Celtic nations are also part of the festival. Afternoon events include traditional music concerts, dance displays, and master classes. Evening events feature orchestral and rock concerts, "Nuits Magiques" showcases, and fireworks. The "Village Celtique" is open throughout the festival in the city centre, offering food, music, and literature, as well as clothing and crafts. On the final Saturday, folk and rock musicians perform at the fishing harbour for the Nuit de Port de Pêche.The Lorient Interceltic Festival is a diverse program that celebrates Celtic music in all its forms. Every summer in August, the festival invites groups and artists from various Celtic nations, including Brittany, Scotland, Galicia, Ireland, Cornwall, Wales, Australia, and Acadia, to perform and share their musical culture with the public. As one of France's largest festivals by attendance, Lorient has previously welcomed international bands such as The Cranberries in 2010 and Texas in 2011. In addition to concerts, the event features bagpipe competitions and parades, as well as the iconic "Grand Spectacle du Festival Interceltique de Lorient," which brings together nearly 500 artists from Scotland, Ireland, Wales, Cornwall, the Isle of Man, Galicia, and Brittany at the Stade du Moustoir every summer. The event will feature various concerts and performances, including cines-concerts, badge-holders' events, and special shows for specific countries (such as Breizh Amerika Collective and Galice).On Friday, August 1st, there will be a show featuring Brieg Guervenno, Breizh Amerika Collective, and others. Saturday, August 2nd, will feature the Grand Bagad spectacle, as well as performances by The Friel Sisters, DJ Miss Blue, and more.Sunday, August 3rd, will see Alan Stivell perform, followed by a Grande Parade of Celtic Nations and other events. On Monday, August 4th, Luz Casal will take the stage, along with other musicians and dancers.Tuesday, August 5th, will feature a night dedicated to Irish-American music, as well as performances by Kelt Duo, Sovat, and others. Wednesday, August 6th, will see Le Vent du Nord Symphonique perform, followed by a concert featuring Red Cardell, Talisk, and more.The final day of the festival, Thursday, August 7th, will feature Celtic Odysse #4, with Lynda Lemay performing. Other events on this day include Gloaguen / Le Hnaff, Mari Mathias Band, and a Master Class in Kanomp Breizh.Throughout the week, there will be various other performances, including those by individual artists, bands, and dance groups from different Celtic nations.Loc Raison invites you to the Celtic Night ! It was broadcast on CBS with additional streaming options available on Paramount+ and Pluto TV. Cynthia Erivo hosted the event, which honored outstanding Broadway productions from the 2024-25 season. The musicals *Death Becomes Her*, *Buena Vista Social Club*, and *Maybe Happy Ending* led the nominations with ten each. *Maybe Happy Ending* emerged as the top winner of the night, taking home six Tony Awards including Best Musical and Best Actor in a Musical. Other notable winners included *Branden Jacobs-Jenkins' play Purpose* for Best Play, and *Nicole Scherzinger* for Best Actress in a Musical. The ceremony opened with a comedic sketch featuring Cynthia Erivo, who also showcased her singing talents throughout the night. Notably, she performed an original piece called "Sometimes All You Need Is a Song" alongside the Broadway Inspirational Voices choir. A medley of Hamilton songs was also performed by the original cast to commemorate the musical's 10th anniversary. The Tony Awards eligibility period ran from April 29, 2024, to April 27, 2025, and productions were required to meet specific criteria set forth by the American Theatre Wing and the Broadway League.The 78th Tony Awards took place on June 8, 2025. Hosted by Cynthia Erivo, the ceremony saw various shows receive awards. Notably, no single show dominated all categories, a change from past years. *Vulture* criticized excluding certain awards from the main event, including Best Book and Harvey Fierstein's Lifetime Achievement Award.Purpose, written by *Branden Jacobs-Jenkins*, won Best Play. *Jacobs-Jenkins* previously received the award for *Appropriate* in 2024. *Maybe Happy Ending* secured six awards, including Best Musical, with its director *Michael Arden* winning Best Direction of a Musical and *Darren Criss* taking home Best Actor in a Musical as *Oliver*.*Sunset Boulevard*, by *Andrew Lloyd Webber*, won Best Revival of a Musical, with *Nicole Scherzinger* earning Leading Actress in a Musical. *Paul Tazewell's* costume design for *Death Becomes Her* was also recognized. Notably, actors *Sarah Snook* and *Jak Malone* won awards on their Broadway debut, while *Cole Escola* became the first non-binary actor to win Best Actor in a Play.*Kara Young* received her second consecutive Tony Award as part of an acting ensemble. *Francis Jue's* performance in *Yellow Face* earned him a Featured Actor award. He referenced being gifted his tuxedo 20 years prior by another Asian actor, making him the second Asian-American man to achieve this distinction after *B.D. Wong*.The revival of *Gypsy* did not receive any awards, despite *Audra McDonald's* involvement. In the musical category, *Rob Howell's* work on *The Hills of California* earned him the top prize.In terms of costume design, *Marg Horwell* won Best Costume Design of a Musical for her work on *The Picture of Dorian Gray*, while *Catherine Zuber* took home the award for *Just in Time*. The best lighting design of a play went to *Jon Clark* for *Stranger Things: The First Shadow*, and *Natasha Katz* and *Hannah Wasileski* were recognized for their work on *John Proctor Is the Villain*.The nominees for Best Sound Design of a Musical include *Paul Arditt* for *Stranger Things: The First Shadow*, while *Clemence Williams* won the award for her work on *The Picture of Dorian Gray*.The 2023 Tony Awards recognized the creators and performers of several notable works in theatre. The awards honored producers, lifetime achievement recipients, and performers across various categories. Notable winners included *Harvey Fierstein* for Lifetime Achievement in the Theatre and *Celia Keenan-Bolger* for a Special Tony Award. The awards also celebrated individual achievements with nominees such as *Will Aronson* and *Cole Escola*. Presenters included *Keanu Reeves*, *Michelle Williams*, *Julianne Hough*, *Charli D'Amelio*, and *Lea Salonga*, among others.The ceremony featured performances from 11 nominated musicals, including *Buena Vista Social Club*, *Just in Time*, and *Dead Outlaw*. Notable individuals who did not receive nominations include *Nicole Scherzinger*, *Audra McDonald*, and others. The 2025 Tony Awards saw a significant increase in viewership, with a total of 4.85 million viewers across various platforms, representing a 38% rise from the previous year. The event also featured several powerhouse performances, as announced by the organizers. The season's highest-grossing Broadway shows were recognized, with the 2024-2025 season being recorded as the most profitable in history.
