How to find out information about someone who has been arrested and booked into the Mini-Cassia Criminal Justice Center. To determine if a person has been recently arrested and booked into the facility, you can contact the jail's booking line at 208-878-1000. The line may direct you to speak with a staff member or provide access to an automated system for searching by name. Be aware that the information about the individual's status is not publicly available immediately after their arrest. Booking Process A recently arrested person will be taken from the police department or Sheriff's office in Cassia County and transported to the Mini-Cassia Criminal Justice Center for booking. During this process, they will receive their Miranda Rights, and then a photo and fingerprints will be taken. The individual will also be asked numerous questions regarding their personal history, state of mind, and any outstanding warrants. Medical procedures may include a breathalyzer test or blood draw if the offender is suspected of DUI. A full body search, which can be humiliating, will also occur. This includes bending over, spreading cheeks in the direction of an officer, coughing, and walking through a metal detector or x-ray machine. During booking, staff will inquire about gang affiliations, medical conditions, prescribed medication, and recreational drugs to ensure the individual's safe placement and address any special needs. During booking, an individual's personal property is typically seized by authorities. This includes clothing, money, jewelry, cell phones, and other items. If the offender remains in custody for a prolonged period, they can authorize a friend or family member to retrieve their belongings by providing written consent. The Mini-Cassia Criminal Justice Center permits property pickup during designated hours with proper identification verification. The booking process at the Mini-Cassia Criminal Justice Center typically takes anywhere from an hour to 24 hours or longer, depending on factors such as the number of individuals awaiting processing, staffing levels, and the offender's behavior. If necessary, the Booking Officer may opt for temporary housing in a holding cell to ensure public safety. Once booked, offenders are granted one free phone call to notify loved ones of their arrest and/or arrange bail. Detained inmates awaiting arraignment will be provided with basic necessities like jail attire, shoes, blankets, and toiletries. Before being transferred to their housing unit, they may be required to take a shower and undergo treatment for lice, scabies, or other infestations.
