Janis, Lehann, and Jackie are invited to a free weekend holiday in Punta Rossa villa but things aren't as expected.Mile High is a British television drama series that follows the lives of the cabin crew members of Fresh!, a budget airline based in London. In the finale, some staff members lose their jobs, while others make significant changes in their personal lives.The characters Ed and Poppy move to Belarus, where they start a family, while Janis and Will leave the airline to open their own bar called 'Mile High'. The series concludes with the airing of its last episodes on Finnish station MTV3 before being broadcast on British channel Sky One.Mile High was officially released in Canada as "Mile High" and later retitled to another name, however, the original title was never confirmed. This merger causes stress for workers, particularly those from Goldstar. Crew uniforms remain blue for all staff, while the main hub is at London Stansted Airport, where external and interior scenes are filmed. Destinations include domestic locations like Leeds Bradford, Belfast, Manchester, Cardiff, Edinburgh, Newcastle, as well as international destinations such as Palma de Majorca, Amsterdam, Paris, Split, Brussels, Helsinki, Kos, Alicante, Faro, Miaga, Milan, Monastir, Toronto, Dubai, and Bahrain. The show's second series consists of 7 episodes followed by a longer third series with 19 episodes. The main storyline in series 2 is the airline's merger with Goldstar, affecting workers and leading to changes in crew uniforms.Mile High is a British TV drama that revolves around the lives of the crew and staff at Fresh! Airlines, with various love interests for main character Dan Peterson. The show features several storylines and characters over two seasons until its conclusion in the series finale where all his love interests exact revenge. As a result of Nigel's heart attack upon landing, Lehan Evans dies in a plane crash, causing Dan to descend into alcoholism. Ed Russell and Poppy Fields move to Minsk, Belarus and have a child, while Janis Steel and Will O'Brien leave the airline to open their own bar named 'Mile High' on a Spanish beach.
