How to position the speaker: [insert page number]. Charging your phone or tablet: charge through USB or power supply port. Connectivity options: USB, Bluetooth/NFC, and 3.5 mm jack. Features include Zoom Talk microphone with adaptive directionality up to 15 ft., built-in charging port for tablets and mobile phones, and option to attach a Kensington lock. Button layout: volume down, mute, volume up, answer call, end/reject call, Bluetooth, power supply port. For optimal audio quality: place the speaker on a flat surface in the center of the meeting group, avoid covering the speaker with stickers or labels, and adjust the volume to suit your needs. To charge your Jabra Speak 810, plug in the power supply and secure the cable. You can also charge your mobile phone or tablet using the built-in charging port. For USB connectivity: ensure the speaker is connected to power, then plug into any USB port on your PC. For Bluetooth connectivity: ensure the speaker is connected to power, tap the Bluetooth button, follow voice-guided instructions, and select the Jabra Speak 810 from your mobile device's Bluetooth list. The speaker can remember up to 900 devices but only has one active connection at a time. To disconnect or permanently connect a device, simply tap the Bluetooth button. Thank you for using the Jabra Speak 810! 1. Press and hold the Bluetooth button for 8 seconds until a stable connection is made. To disconnect, press and hold again. Page 1212Jabra Speak 8101. Ensure the device is connected to power using the supplied adapter. 2. Bring your NFC-enabled phone close to the NFC zone on the Jabra Speak 810. A connection will be confirmed on your mobile device. NOTE: To detach your phone, bring it close again. Page 1313Jabra Speak 8101. Insert the Link 360 into your computer and wait for the drivers to install automatically. When the Link 360 lights up blue, pair with the Jabra Speak 810 by pressing the Bluetooth button. You will hear a confirmation when connected. NOTE: To disconnect, press the Bluetooth button again.
