How to Convert Images to JPG Files on Various Devices To upload photos to websites or apps that require JPG format, convert your files from other extensions such as GIF, TIFF, or PNG. Using online converters is one option; simply do a web search for "convert XXX to jpg online" where XXX represents the type of file you want to convert. You can use smartphones, tablets, and even computers connected to the internet to find suitable converters like Online-Convert that support multiple file types. Always ensure the chosen site handles your image type. If you have access to Wi-Fi instead of using data on your mobile device, it will help reduce the time spent converting files since they are large in size. To get started: 1 Go to a converter website and follow their instructions 2 Choose an image file from your computer or enter its URL online Once you've completed these steps you can download your converted image To convert an image to JPEG, navigate to the desired folder and select "Save as type" to ensure it's set to JPEG. Rename the file if needed, then click "Save." Your file is now converted. Next, open the image with Preview or another software like GIMP. For Preview, Ctrl + click on the image and choose "Open With" > "Preview." If you encounter issues, try using a web converter or download the image first. In Preview, go to "File" > "Export," change the format to JPEG, adjust quality and resolution if desired, then save with a new name ending in ".jpg" (case-insensitive). The file must be on your computer for this method to work. Alternatively, use GIMP by downloading and installing it first. Open the image, go to "File" > "Export As," choose JPEG, modify options such as preview settings and quality, then export with a new name in a chosen location. If you have an existing JPEG file with the wrong extension (e.g., ".JGP"), changing the file extension can be useful, but be aware it won't technically convert the image. Note the original file extension so you can change it back if needed. To make a JPEG file, start by finding the filename of the image on your Mac or PC. If using Windows, you can skip this step. On a Mac, click once on the image and go to "File" then "Get Info." Uncheck the box next to "Name and Extension" and save the changes. Next, delete the current file extension from the filename by erasing everything after the period. On a Mac, click the image once and press [⌘] Return, then select the end of the file extension and press Delete until you've removed it. In Windows, right-click the image and select "Rename," then click at the end of the file extension and press ← Backspace to delete everything after the period. After that, type JPG (or JPEG) after the period in your filename, making sure to keep it lowercase or uppercase as needed. Your filename should now look something like this: image.jpeg or image.jpg. Both JPEG and JPG are acceptable file extensions. Finally, confirm your changes by clicking "Use.jpg" or "Yes." This will make the file name end in .JPG, allowing you to save the image as a JPEG file. It's worth noting that changing the file extension can potentially make the file unusable, so be cautious when making this change. To manually download images from webpages onto various devices, follow these steps: Tap and hold the desired image in a web browser to access options. On iPhone, tap "Save to Photos" for instant saving. Android users can select "Download image" or opt for "Share icon" on older devices. For desktop computers, right-click (or control-click) on the image, then choose "Save Image As..." and specify a file type like JPEG or PNG. Once saved, you can locate your photos in their respective apps, such as Photos or Gallery. A pop-up menu will appear; tap Download image (mobile) or click Save Image As... (desktop). 4. Choose a save location and filename, ensuring it's in JPEG or PNG format for optimal viewing. Alternatively, you can store images in Google Collections: * On mobile, tap the Add to button below the image. * On desktop, expand an image and select Add to. To save an image from Google search results, follow these steps: Right-click on the image and select Save Image As. Choose a location and filename, then click Save. If you're signed in to your Google account, you can add images to Collections. Tap the Add to icon below the selected image or choose "Add to" when saving an image from the search results page. A notification will appear indicating which collection the image has been added to. To access Collections, run an image search and tap the Menu icon (three horizontal lines). Then, select Collections. You can also access Collections by selecting the three dots (...) below the search bar on Google.com or under the list of Google Apps. Download Images from Websites to Your Device ##### Downloading Images with a Mobile Device To download an image on your iPhone or iPad: 1. Open a web browser and find the desired image. 2. Tap and hold the image until the menu appears, then tap "Save to Photos". 3. Select the location where you want to save the image. On Android devices: 1. Open a web browser and find the desired image. 2. Tap and hold the image until the menu appears, then tap "Download image". 3. Choose the desired quality of the image when it downloads. ##### Downloading Images with a Desktop To download an image on your desktop computer: 1. Open a web browser and navigate to the desired website or search for images using Google. 2. Find the desired image, right-click on it, and select "Save Image As..." from the menu. 3. Choose the location where you want to save the image. Before downloading an image from a website, ensure that you have permission to do so. Selecting a Download Location for an Image on Your Computer To set the default download location for images on your computer, follow these steps: Click on the image you want to download to open its full size version in the browser window. Right click (or control-click) on the image and select "Save image as" from the menu. Choose a folder where you would like to save the picture and type in a new name for the file if desired. Click Save to save the image to your computer. How to Save Images from Websites 1. Open a web browser, such as Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox. 2. Search for the image you want to download on Google or navigate to the website where it's located. 3. Tap "Images" below the search bar to see associated images and tap on the one you want. 4. If not already open, tap the image to view its source; then tap and hold to open a pop-up menu. 5. Select "Download Image" from the menu. The image will be saved to your device.
