Download Apps on Your Smart TV: A Step-by-Step Guide1 Turn on your TV and make sure it's connected to the Internet.[19] Some TVs, like those from Sony, Element, Hisense, LeECO, Sharp, Toshiba, or Westinghouse, are compatible with Google or Android TV. For Apple TVs, ensure you're using a 4th generation model or newer.2 Press your remote's HOME button, then scroll down to the "Apps" section and select Store.[20] Browse for apps by swiping through categories like Entertainment, swipe up to search, or explore specific sections like TV Remote Games.3 Select an app you want to download and tap the remote. Click the apps panel and enter the PIN 12345 when prompted. A window for Developer Mode configuration will appear; set it to ON and enter the IP address of your computer. Once you've done this, restart your TV to apply the changes.You can now download third-party apps using either internal or external methods. One way is to use a command prompt on your computer or a storage device.To install apps on your Samsung Smart TV, follow these steps:1. Go to the home screen and navigate to the "Apps" section using the smart remote.2. Select an app to install by pressing the "Select" button and then the "Install" button.3. The app will download and install automatically.After installation, you can open and use the app on your TV.Note: Some apps may be added to specific sections of the home screen, such as Media Home or Game Home.You must agree to the Terms and Conditions before proceeding. Select APPS.3. Select the search icon (magnifying glass).4. Enter app name, then select Done.5. Select Install.Given article text here Locking Apps on Samsung Smart TV for Security-----Some apps on a Samsung smart TV do not display a screen asking if you want to exit. In such cases, the app will close immediately after pressing the return button.App Locking with PIN Code-----Locking and unlocking an app on Samsung smart TVs allows you to lock any app using a PIN code. This feature prevents anyone without the PIN from accessing or using the app. Note that the PIN code used is the same as your TV's security code, which is set to 0000 by default.To access this feature:1. Press the home button on the remote control.2. Move the cursor to APPS and press the enter button.3. Move the cursor to Settings (gear/cog) icon and press the enter button.4. Select Lock/Unlock, then press the enter button.Locking an app requires entering the PIN code every time you try to access it. The default TV PIN is 0000.When an app is locked, a lock icon appears next to its name. To unlock an app, select Lock/Unlock again.Moving and Removing Apps-----To move or remove an app on your smart TV:1. Press the home button on the remote control.2. Move the cursor to the app you'd like to move or remove and press the down button.3. Select Move (or Remove).4. Move the selected app to its desired position or confirm removal.Running Network Connection Test-----If your smart TV is not connected to the internet, running a network test can help determine the issue:1. Navigate to Settings.2. Select General.3. Select Network.4. Choose Network Status.5. The image displayed will indicate if your TV is connected to the router and the router's connection status.Checking for Software Updates-----Regular software updates may resolve issues with your smart TV. Check for updates:1. Navigate to Settings.2. Select Support.3. Select Software Update.4. Choose Update Now.Troubleshooting Individual Apps-----If an app is not working correctly, try deleting and reinstalling it:1. Press the home button on the remote control.2. Move the cursor to the app you'd like to remove and press the down button.3. Select Remove (and then again).4. Press the home button to return to the main menu.5. Move the cursor to APPS and press the up button.6. Move the cursor to the app's name and press the enter button.Select the app you wish to add, then click the up button. Next, place the cursor on "Add to Home" and press enter. Finally, drag the app to your preferred location and confirm by pressing the enter button again.

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
