Information and Instructions

IBD Connect Inc. is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization with a mission to support, engage, and empower pediatric inflammatory bowel disease (IBD) patients and their families. Our comprehensive programs and educational resources are designed to nurture the family dynamic, foster a sense of community, and facilitate the transition of pediatric IBD patients into adulthood. As part of our mission, IBD Connect Inc. is pleased to announce the launch of our scholarship program for the 2026-2027 academic year. To support the educational aspirations of students impacted by IBD, we will be awarding two scholarships, each valued at \$1,000, to eligible applicants who are enrolled in a U.S. college, university, or trade/vocational school for the upcoming 2026-2027 academic school year.

Application Criteria:

Applicants are eligible to apply if they:

- Are a U.S. citizen or legal resident.
- Have been diagnosed with either Crohn's disease or ulcerative colitis.
- Are a graduating high school senior.
- Are enrolled in a U.S. college, university, or trade/vocational school for the upcoming 2026-2027 academic year.
- Have active involvement in one of IBD Connect's support groups or be an active volunteer with the organization.

Application Requirements:

To apply for the IBD Connect Inc. Scholarship, applicants must submit the following documents:

- Completed scholarship application form (separate document).
- Essay requirement (please see scholarship application form for prompt).
- Proof of U.S. citizenship (e.g., copy of passport, birth certificate, or naturalization certificate).
- Proof of enrollment in a U.S. college, university, or trade/vocational school for the academic year 2026-2027 (e.g., class schedule, enrollment confirmation).
- Documentation confirming the diagnosis of Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD) from a healthcare provider (e.g., doctor's letter, medical records).



Application Submission and Deadline:

Please submit your completed application and supporting documents via email to Lisa Fournier at lisafournier@ibdconnectinc.org by **May 31st, 2026**. You may also choose to upload your application and supporting documents to IBD Connect's website, www.ibdconnectinc.org, by the same date. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Selection Process:

The IBD Connect Inc. Board of Directors will review all applications and will select the scholarship recipients based on the eligibility criteria and personal essay. The two scholarship winners will be contacted by June 30th, 2026.
