This individual will develop and deliver engaging lessons on construction trades, including both theoretical and practical skills. They will assess participants' progress and maintain a safe learning environment. The Instructor will facilitate learning through a structured curriculum and hands-on activities, ensuring participants gain essential skills and certifications.

The person in this role will be required to work 3-4 hours, three days a week, and 8 hours on Saturdays.

RESPONSIBILITIES
