Impact and application (1-2 pages)	Describe how your project strengthens teaching and curriculum development within Universal Design in a Danish context. Explain how you will apply your new knowledge about universal design in your own teaching and give concrete examples. Describe what impact your project will have for others – for people, for society, and for your field in Denmark.
Personal outcomes	Describe your personal outcomes from the Bevica Scholarship Programme: • List your three main experiences from receiving a Bevica Scholarship grant • Would you recommend the Bevica Scholarship Programme to others? If yes, explain why • If your studies have resulted in articles, publications, speaking opportunities, additional funding or other outputs, please attach them or include links
References	List the three most important references you would recommend future Bevica Scholars to read. Describe briefly why you recommend each one.
