Readings this Week: Every few years today's feast coincides with a Sunday and so gives us the opportunity to reflect on the cross in our Sunday celebration of the Resurrection. It captures the heart of the Christian paradox: that an instrument of torture, an instrument used to impose power on the weak, would become the sign of hope generation after generation. The cross reminds us that nothing in this world can separate us from the love of God (cf. Romans 8:38) and for this reason it adorns our churches, our walls and even our jewellery.

Evangelii Gaudium Sunday and Education Sunday: Next Sunday, the third in September, is now known as *Evangelii Gaudium* Sunday (formerly known as Home Missions Sunday). There will be a second collection next Sunday to support the work of the Directorate of Mission at the Bishop's Conference. Today is Education Sunday and we pray for the Catholic Education Service.
