



What mothers need after birth

-  **To reach their newborns from the bed.** Recovery, discomfort, and limited mobility make standing and reaching into a high-walled tub difficult, especially after a cesarean section.
-  **To support feeding and skin-to-skin contact.** Easy bedside access helps a mother respond to her baby's cues and keep her newborn close, which is what continuous rooming-in is meant to support.
-  **To care for their babies independently.** Being able to pick up and set down a newborn without waiting for help promotes rest, confidence, and dignity during the stay.



How the Couplet Care Bassinet supports families

Designed for safe infant handling at the bedside

The Couplet Care Bassinet can easily extend over the hospital bed and adjusts in height, so a mother can reach her infant while seated or reclining. A removable sidewall completes that access: it nests inside the tub during bedside use and covers the access points for transport. A traditional hospital bassinet has high, fixed walls built for a clinician standing over the infant, which is what makes bedside reaching difficult.

What the research indicates

In research funded by the National Institutes of Health, mothers randomized to use the Couplet Care Bassinet reported high satisfaction and called for nursing assistance significantly less often, and their infants spent less time out of the room for non-medical reasons. It is the only bassinet that enables every postpartum mother to pick up, hold, and return her newborn independently, without requiring a nurse or other adult in the room.

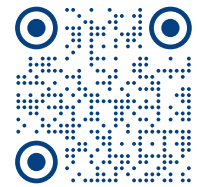
Enhancing the quality care you provide

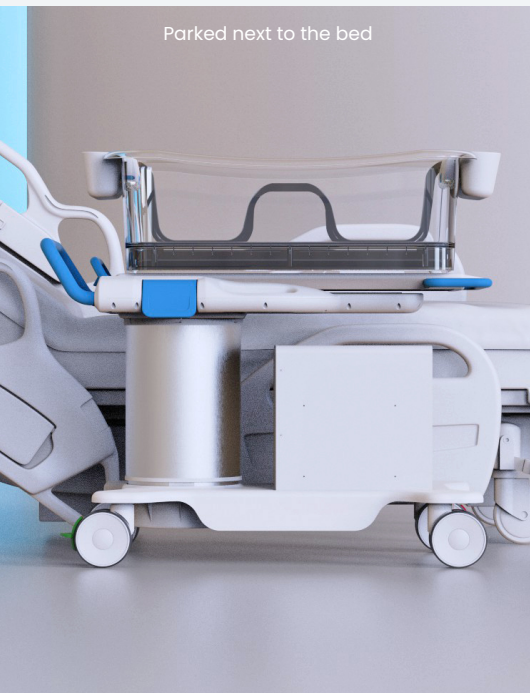
How might your facility get the bassinet?

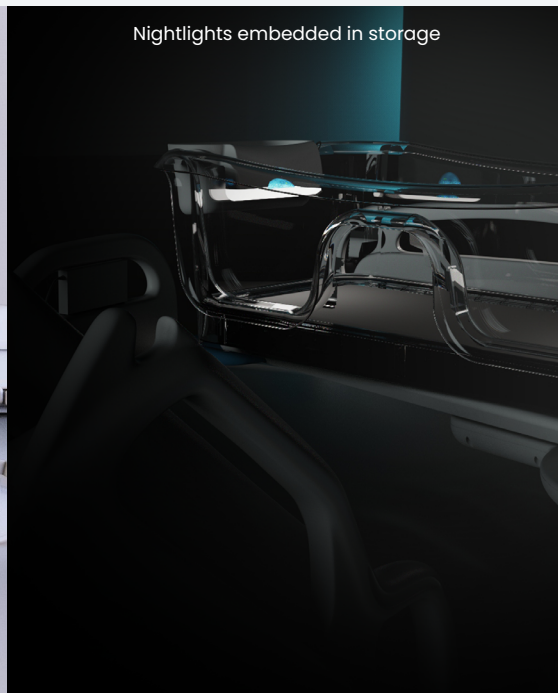
