Dungeon Defenders is a hybrid multiplayer video game developed by Trendy Entertainment that combines tower defense and action role-playing elements. The game takes place in a fantasy setting where players control young apprentices, defending against hordes of monsters. In the game, one to four players work together to protect Eternia Crystals from enemy waves, using towers, traps, melee, and ranged attacks to defeat enemies. Players can upgrade their equipment and defenses, but must manage limited mana resources. If a crystal is damaged beyond repair, the level is lost. Successful defense earns experience points and bonuses for preventing damage to crystals or characters. Completing all waves in a level rewards players with a large banked mana boost and allows them to sell items for additional resources. The game features various modes such as hardcore mode which improves rewards but prevents respawning during combat. On non-challenge levels, survival and "pure strategy" modes are unlocked after beating the campaign. These modes have more waves that get progressively harder but can give better loot. For classic campaign levels, players must work through each level before unlocking the next, though they can return to cleared levels to try and improve their performance or grind for rewards. Characters are persistent across playthroughs and can be selected from available classes with unique abilities and defenses. The Steam version allows up to 40 characters, while Trendy's ranked servers have a separate limit. Characters can be managed and overridden between ranked and unranked play. The game features four main character classes and eight additional downloadable content classes. Each class has its own set of exclusive special abilities. As characters level up, players can allocate points among various characteristics that affect the character or their defenses. Equipment can be purchased using banked mana in the store or from other players' auctions. New equipment can also be collected from killing monsters or beating levels. Banked mana can be spent to upgrade equipment, improving its bonuses and attributes. The game supports cross-platform play between PlayStation 3 and PlayStation Vita, as well as PC and console versions on Xbox Live Arcade, PlayStation Network, and Steam. Upon release in October and December 2011, Dungeon Defenders received generally positive reviews from critics, with scores ranging from 6 to 9 out of 10. The game's overall Metacritic score was 81, 80, and 77 for PC, PS3, and Xbox 360 respectively. Dungeon Defenders had a strong performance on various platforms including Xbox 360. Within the first two weeks of its release, the game sold over 250,000 copies and by the end of 2011, this number rose to 600,000. By February 2012, the publisher reported that the game had achieved one million sales across Xbox Live, PlayStation Network, and Steam.[26] [27] First Wave was the mobile version of Dungeon Defenders which was initially available for iOS and Android. The release of a recent patch allowed cross-platform multiplayer gaming between these two platforms via GameSpy. Second Wave was another mobile version that offered improved controls and a revamped menu system but was later removed from Google Play as of December 2012. In July 2014, Dungeon Defenders Eternity was released which rebalanced the heroes and enemies and redesigned the loot system of the original game.[29] This update included an early version of Playverse, a server system designed to enhance cross-platform support and prevent hacking. However, customers on Steam were largely dissatisfied with the inclusion of microtransactions on the first day of release and the absence of a single-player game mode, leading to predominantly negative reviews. The game is no longer available for purchase on Steam. Redux is a community-developed expansion mod that was initially distributed through Discord before getting official support from Chromatic Games in December 2020. This mod allows players with the base game on Steam to access it as a 'beta' branch. A separate sequel, Dungeon Defenders II, was showcased at the 2013 PAX East convention and featured similar gameplay to its predecessor.[31] The game is free-to-play but offers microtransactions to unlock certain heroes through play. It was initially released in early access on Steam in December 2014 and later became available on PlayStation 4 in September 2015, alongside a version for Xbox One which was launched on June 20, 2017.[33] In 2019, Chromatic Games unveiled Dungeon Defenders: Awakened, another sequel to the series. It had a successful Kickstarter backing in the same month and featured several gameplay updates while returning to the art style established by the first game. Players who pre-ordered the title gained access to its beta version which launched in November 2019 for Microsoft Windows. The game entered Steam's early access on February 21, 2020, before being fully released on May 28 of that year. It later became available on Xbox One on March 17, 2021, followed by a Nintendo Switch release on August 4. [37][38] A version for PlayStation 4 was launched on May 3, 2022. Additionally, Chromatic Games developed an action role-playing roguelite spin-off titled Dungeon Defenders: Going Rogue which released in early access for Microsoft Windows on March 29, 2022. The video game Dungeon Defenders was released on various platforms, including Nintendo Switch, PlayStation 4, PlayStation 5, Xbox One, and Xbox Series X/S. The game was developed by Trendy Entertainment and published by Epic Games. Dungeon Defenders was initially released in December 2010 for iPhone and iPad, but later expanded to other platforms such as PC, PlayStation 3, and Xbox 360. The game received positive reviews from critics, with praise for its unique gameplay mechanics and graphics.
