

What is the Northland Community Foundation?

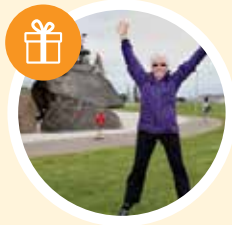

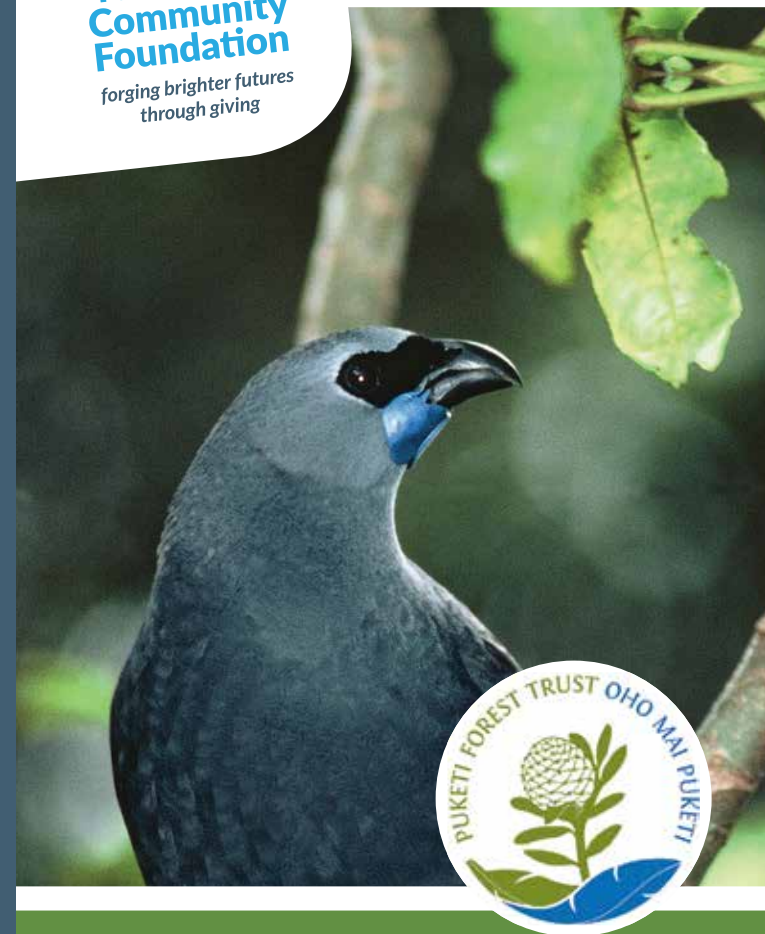

Puketi Forest Trust

Puketi Forest Trust was registered as a charitable trust in 2003 with the aim of restoring Puketi Forest to a complete, healthy forest and maintaining it in perpetuity. Puketi Forest contains magnificent stands of kauri, podocarp and hardwood trees and has a rich ecological diversity including 370 recorded species of plants, some of which are found nowhere else in the world, and a number of threatened species including both long and short-tailed bats. It has rich historical and cultural significance for many communities in the Far North.

The Puketi Forest Endowment Fund will secure the future of the forest

Your gift to the endowment fund will continue to help protect Puketi Forest forever because the capital will be retained by Northland Community Foundation and invested to provide income for pest control, re-introductions and forest restoration in accordance with the Puketi Forest Trust deed. Donations can be linked to specific purposes of the Trust if you wish.

Pest Control

To protect the forest and its native wildlife from introduced predators, the Trust has established a permanent trapping network over 5,500 hectares of Puketi Forest. Traps are maintained year-round by specialist contractors and a team of dedicated volunteers to control stoats, possums, rats and feral cats. Pest control methods are constantly reviewed and upgraded as new knowledge becomes available.

Bringing Back the Missing Species

With effective pest control, kiwi, kukupa (native pigeon), tui and other birds have more than doubled within the management area. Kokako and toutouwai (North Island Robin) have been successfully re-introduced and more re-introductions are planned.
