What is the Northland Environment Fund?

The Northland Environment Fund encourages donations and bequests from individuals, organisations and businesses who want to contribute towards a permanent legacy for the long-term benefit of the environment in Te Tai Tokerau Northland, while also working to improve community outcomes. The fund will deliver grants to local organisations, groups, and charities that are working to protect and restore Northland's environment.

A fund for Northland - forever

Donations to this Fund are never spent. Instead they are invested, with the interest earned each year going back to the community through grants. By gifting to this Fund, you're investing in the people and places that make our region special — today and forever.

Anyone can contribute

Donations and bequests of all sizes are encouraged and welcomed. Representatives from across Northland will work with Northland Community Foundation trustees to advise on any distribution of grants from the Fund. All donations to the Fund will be pooled with others, increasing their effectiveness. The faster the Northland Environment Fund grows, the greater the amount the Fund will be able to distribute in grants each year.

Supporting environmental groups across Northland

This Fund will support organisations who are working to protect and restore the environment, and to protect native species including kiwi. Across Te Tai Tokerau, this kind of work is already happening and the Fund exists to help it grow.

Restoration and protection of land and ocean

From hapū-led riparian planting and wetland monitoring on the west coast to large-scale predator control on the Bay of Islands peninsulas, communities across Northland are restoring native ecosystems and protecting the land and ocean for future generations.

Building climate resilience

Healthy forests, wetlands and coastlines are Northland's best defence against a changing climate. The Fund will support initiatives that restore these environments and strengthen the region's long-term resilience.

Environmental education and advocacy

When people are informed, connected and empowered, communities are capable of remarkable conservation work. The Fund will support environmental education and advocacy that enables Northlanders to protect what matters most in their region.

Te Tai Tokerau Northland's natural environments are taonga that belong to all of us, and to the generations that will follow.

Mahi tahi – working together

Grants from this Fund will prioritise:

- Hapū partnerships: initiatives that enhance the mana of communities caring for their whenua and waterways
- Community outcomes: projects that make a real difference in low-decile communities through local involvement
- Employment: creating jobs in environmental restoration and conservation
- Education and advocacy: empowering Northlanders to understand and protect te taiao (the environment)
