2. Read Jeremiah 31:31-34 and Ezekiel 36:26-27. Why was a "new covenant" necessary? What was wrong with the old one?
3. Read Matthew 5:17-19 and Matthew 22:37-40. How would you summarize Jesus' attitude toward the Old Testament Law? How does His teaching affect your perspective on the Ten Commandments?
4. Read the passages on your outline that were written by the apostle Paul. How does his teaching on God's Law change or reinforce your understanding of the Ten Commandments?
5. In light of the progressive revelation of God that we studied on Sunday, how would you explain a Christian's relationship to the Ten Commandments to a new Jesus-follower?
