OUR HISTORY

In the summer of 1992, twelve families joined together to ask God to lead them in the planting of a Bible teaching church committed to having an impact in the western suburbs of Cleveland. The group met for six months to worship, pray and plan together. Our first public worship service was held in a small childcare facility in February 1993.

When Providence Church outgrew the childcare facilities, we moved to a middle school building in Westlake. In 2002, we purchased land in Avon and had building plans established. We held our first worship service at our current location in December 2003.

In September of 2019, Dr. Austin Shaw began serving as senior pastor. Under Austin's shepherding our church maintains its commitment to biblical doctrine, expository preaching, and Christ-centered community.

Forming Families

Scripture describes a church as a family. This means that men and women, single and married, young and old, will grow in the Lord together. Providence is blessed to have many children in our assembly. Between September 2022 and September 2024, 48 babies were born into our church. This combined with many large families moving into our area means we have thriving children's and youth ministries.

Equipping Saints

By now many of us have seen the data on the "dechurching of America". Dechurching refers to the number of people who have left the Church in the last 30 years. This, coupled with secularizing trends, awakens us to the need for catechizing one another. Given the number of able teachers in our family and a preponderance of thoughtful people, we will be a congregation devoted to learning Scripture and preparing one another to be Christ-followers in this complex world (Ephesians 4.11-16).

Multiplying Churches

Since its formation, Providence has wanted to plant more Bible teaching, Christ-honoring churches. We want to "go out to the highways and hedges and compel people to come in" to the Kingdom (Luke 14.23).

Healthy churches with a critical mass of people provide the best context for the training of future church leaders.
