2.2 Schedule

There will be a SailGP racing format practice session on Saturday, March 28th. This session will involve the organizers setting up a GP format racecourse with a course boundary and the new Virtual Boundary (VB) software available for anyone interested in participating. Practice races will be conducted to get sailors familiar with the GP courses as well as the new VB software loaded on their phones. This session is open to anyone who has registered for at least one day of scheduled SailGP racing.

There will be two informal BBQ's at the camp on the playa planned at 5:30PM for Sunday, March 29th and Wednesday, April 1st (weather permitting) sponsored by NABSA and free to all participants. Anyone planning to participate in one or both of these are asked to inform the Rec Fleet chair John Wright (jwright713@aol.com) for a head count on each evening. Volunteers are also welcomed and desired to help with putting on the BBQ's.

8 Updated Rules for Event

8.9 Any disabled or physically impaired sailors in the event will have an X marked on the bottom of their pod or kart that will be visible to other sailors in the event of a capsized. As a reminder to other participants, and in accordance with IBRA rule A.9, a competitor shall give all practicable help to any person in danger and any competitor that renders assistance during a race may file a written request for redress with the Protest Committee.

Add your name.


