## Gently sharing the gospel

Chapter 15 is a drop-in shelter that is bringing life to people who experience homelessness in Thetford, UK. They offer showers, laundry, clothing, refreshments, haircuts and foot care, alongside friendship and support. Mike, one of the team, explains the impact Chapter 15 has in people's lives: "One man who had not had a shower or haircut in years sat outside and cried tears of joy: 'You have no idea what it means to me to be clean, have a shave and my hair cut, and to be wearing clean clothes.'"

When the team wanted to share the Bible's good news with their guests, Mike ordered some of the Lifewords Little Books: "When we took over running the centre in April, our biggest challenge was how to share the Bible's good news with such hurting and struggling people. We ordered some of the Little Book series and thought that this could be our way of gently sharing the gospel and encouraging our guests.

"We saw guests taking them and starting to read them, and then a number asked if they could keep them. One guest spoke to another about how the booklets contain Bible verses and how encouraging they were. Another guest, who spoke about her experience of loneliness and despair, asked if she could have one of each and came back the next week to say she had read all of them, that the words were a help and an encouragement, and that she now kept them by her bed in her room at the hostel. These Little Books have provided a way for us to gently share the gospel in a non-threatening way, and we are very grateful that Lifewords has made this possible. Our prayer is that God will continue to use these books to share God's love with the guests who visit Chapter 15."

19–25 October Elzbieta's story The Lifewords blog is full of stories from people who have found life through Lifewords resources. Here, Elzbieta shares about how she came to faith:

"On the second-to-last day of our A-level exams, my friend and I went into the chemistry lab. On the desk was a booklet titled *Little Book of Chaos*, a resource from Lifewords that had been used during a Christian Union session in the classroom. I picked it up, saw that it was about Christianity and rolled my eyes, but before I could put it back, my chemistry teacher walked into the lab and encouraged me to take it home. He explained it was about faith and mental health, and thought it might help. I told him I didn't need God, but being sentimental and feeling incredibly lost at the end of college, I placed it in a memory box I kept under my bed.

"A few days after leaving college, I was in my room when I suddenly felt a strong urge to open the *Little Book of Chaos*. I tried to ignore it. It seemed random and out of place, but I couldn't get my mind off it. So, I pulled out the memory box and opened the booklet at a random page. There I saw a quote from Isaiah 43. I looked up the full passage and my eyes landed on these words: 'I have summoned you by name; you are mine'. After years of searching for identity and meaning, those words silenced the noise. In that moment, everything made sense. Through the chills and emotion, I finally felt clarity and once again believed that God is real, and he is with me. I didn't understand why God would want anything to do with someone like me, but I knew, without a doubt, that I believed in Christ and wanted to know more."
