Schools work in Uganda

Thank you for praying for our partners Spiritual Nurture International (SNI) last month. SNI has recently reached out to over 16,000 students across 30 schools in Busia, Uganda, strengthening existing relationships, introducing new discipleship programmes, and sharing Lifewords resources. There was overwhelming student and teacher participation, a hunger to learn more, and much interest in starting Spiritual Nurture Clubs in the schools. In one instance, a student whose parents had died, shared: “I feel like God brought this team just for me.” Many students requested Bibles and prayer follow up. James Ojambo from SNI explains how important Lifewords resources are for the ministry: “Lifewords resources help enrich the outreach programme by providing evangelism and discipleship resources that present the gospel clearly, encourage personal reflection, and nurture spiritual growth among children and youth, both in and beyond the classroom.”
