Elizabeth, who heads up Lifewords supporter engagement, shares what The True Light means to her:

"At Christmas, when the focus is on decorations, food, and festive activities, it is easy to lose sight of those who struggle with the trappings of the season. While for some Christmas is about presents and family, refreshment and joy, for those with lives too hard, too damaged, too alone, too *much*, it can be difficult to see how Christmas has anything to offer.

"The True Light tells the Christmas story in a way that acknowledges the humanity of those who struggle, and offers them the wonder of a baby born to save the world in a way that makes sense through burden and hardship, as well as light and laughter. The True Light meets us where we are – in the hopes, dreams, and disappointments of our everyday lives.

"If you are someone who finds the trappings of Christmas hard, but is still searching for meaning beyond the madness, or a church reaching out to those on the margins of your community, *The True Light* might just be the resource for you."

Reaching the world with digital resources

Jarek Jankowski, Global Bible Resources Director, shares some exciting news from our Poland office:

"This last October was an extraordinary month in terms of the reach of our animations! In just one month, we recorded almost one million views of our digital publications – *An Invitation* and *Finding Hope* animations. This is more than the total number from January to September combined – and this year's results have already been excellent.

"These fantastic results are largely due to the growing popularity of our Spanish-language animations, reaching viewers across the entire Spanish-speaking world, followed by Thai and Brazilian Portuguese. Our classic printed Bible resources in Portuguese and Spanish have always been among the most widely used, so it's deeply encouraging to see our digital resources now becoming so popular in Latin America as well. The good response from Thailand has been a joyful surprise – especially since the distribution of our printed materials there is quite limited.

"We give thanks for every person reached and pray that these simple messages of Scripture will continue to shine where they are most needed."

21–27 December Inspiring young people in Zimbabwe

Peter Nyangara from Zimbabwe is passionate about Lifewords resources – he loves the way the message is packaged in every booklet. He shares booklets such as *An Invitation, Little Book of Prayer* and *Finding Hope* with individuals, organisations and churches:

"The past three months have been so exciting in ministry, despite other challenges, because of the gifts of booklets from Lifewords. I had an opportunity to give some [Lifewords resources] to boys at our church on Father's Day as I was speaking on what it takes to be a father. It was exciting to take them through lessons using the booklets.

"[Someone else from the church] mentioned to me how the Lifewords booklets are helping her reach out to children in her community and pray with them. The children are using *Daily Strength* and *Little Book of Prayer*, picking verses to lead their families on daily evening prayers. This has surprised some parents who come to find out the source of change they see in their children. One mother ... [shared] a testimony about how her daughter read Scriptures and prayed for her healing when she was sick."
