<sup>6</sup>“Do not give what is holy to dogs, and do not throw your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you to pieces.

<sup>7</sup>“Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.

<sup>8</sup>“For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.

<sup>9</sup>“Or what man is there among you who, when his son asks for a loaf, will give him a stone?

<sup>10</sup>“Or if he asks for a fish, he will not give him a snake, will he?

<sup>11</sup>“If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give what is good to those who ask Him!

<sup>12</sup>“Therefore, in all things, whatever you want people to do for you, so do for them, for this is the Law and the Prophets.

2 - What is the difference between discerning and being judgmental? Are there ways that you judge others the way Jesus warned about in **v.1-5**?

3 - Consider the warning of Jesus in **v.6**. When is an appropriate time to withhold sharing the gospel? Are there any situations your fellowship group can be praying for?

4 - In **v.7-11**, we see Jesus calling us to persistent prayer. What prevents us from praying persistently and how do these verses encourage us? Write something you want to pray for consistently this week.

5 - **ACTION ITEM:** Jesus tells us to DO for others what you would want them to do for you. What is one way you want to change how you treat others? Share an action with the group to follow-up on in a couple weeks.
