Godliness: A consistent mindfulness of God and His Word that shapes our thinking, attitudes, and actions towards submission to His will and conformity to His character.

²Older men are to be temperate, dignified, sensible, sound in faith, in love, in perseverance.

#1 - Older Men v.2

³Older women likewise are to be reverent in their behavior, not malicious gossips nor enslaved to much wine, teaching what is good,

⁴so that they may instruct the young women in sensibility: to love their husbands, to love their children,

#2 - Older Women v.3-4a

⁵to be sensible, pure, workers at home, kind, being subject to their own husbands, so that the word of God will not be slandered.

#3 - Younger Women v.4b-5

FELLOWSHIP GROUP QUESTIONS

- 1 Why is godliness important for the women of the church? What characterizes a godly women?
- 2 Godliness is learned from the Word and from godly people. What woman is currently the biggest influence in your life? Is she godly?
- 3 Words like REVERENT and SENSIBLE emphasize the importance of guarding our thinking. How is thinking connected to our actions? What does it look like to cultivate a REVERENT or SENSIBLE thought life?
- 4 Why are women tempted to gossip? How do we avoid this sin?
- 5 -Why do the young women need to be taught to love their husbands and children? What does this look like in the life of the believer and the life of the church?
- 6 Sensibility is brought up again for young women. What are specific situations where women need to guided by truth and not by their feelings?
- 7 There are A LOT of ways women can apply this sermon. Write down 1-2 specific steps you want to take to apply Paul's teaching for women.
