The Equipping Class meets in the gym at 9:00 AM on Sunday. Kids Ministry and Student Ministry is available at this time as well.

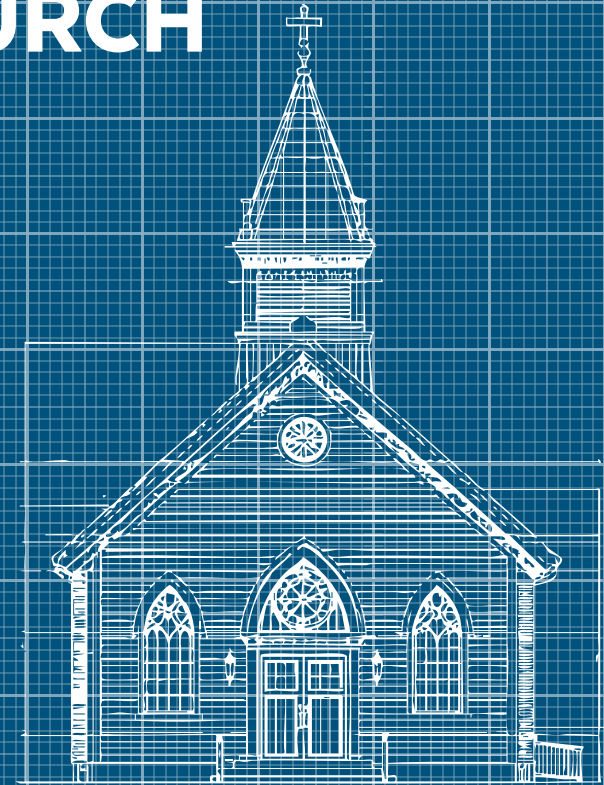

#1 – Younger Women: _____ v.4-5

⁴so that they may

women in sensibility: to
love their husbands, to
love their children,

⁵to be sensible, pure,
workers at home, kind,
being subject to their
own husbands, so that
the word of God will not
be slandered.

#2 – Younger Men: _____ v.6-8

⁶Likewise urge the
younger men to be
sensible;

⁷in all things show
yourself to be a model of
good works, with purity
in doctrine, dignified,

⁸sound in word which is
irreproachable, so that
the opponent will be put
to shame, having nothing
bad to say about us.

#3 – Employees: _____ v.9-10

⁹Urge slaves to be
subject to their own
masters in everything, to
be pleasing, not
contradicting,

¹⁰not pilfering, but
demonstrating all good
faith so that they will
adorn the doctrine of
God our Savior in
everything.

1 - What stood out to you from our study of **Titus 2:1-10**?

2 - How do you want to grow in prioritizing holiness? How do you want to grow in prioritizing the home?

For the older women:

1 - How can you help the younger women pursue the things Paul is instructing?

For the men:

1 - How do Paul's instructions for young men differ from the way the culture views manhood?

2 - Which area of instruction (**verses 6-8**) do you most need to work on? OR Are you able to present yourself as a model of these things to the less mature men? How do you plan to grow? **Read 1 Timothy 4:12**

For employees:

1 - Does your character at work "adorn the doctrine of God our savior"? How do you need to grow in this?
