The Equipping Class meets in the gym at $9:00\,\mathrm{AM}$ on Sunday. Kids Ministry and Student Ministry is available at this time as well.



Living our Doctrine pt.2

Titus 2:4-10

November 9, 2025 - Pastor Josh Petras - Sermon 8 in our study of Titus		
#1 - Younger Women:	v.4-5	⁴ so that they may instruct the young women in sensibility: to love their husbands, to love their children,
		⁵ to be sensible, pure, workers at home, kind, being subject to their own husbands, so that the word of God will not be slandered.
#2 - Younger Men:	v.6-8	⁶ Likewise urge the younger men to be sensible;
		⁷ in all things show yourself to be a model of good works, with purity in doctrine, dignified,
		⁸ sound in word which is irreproachable, so that the opponent will be put to shame, having nothing bad to say about us.
#3 - Employees:	v.9-10	⁹ Urge slaves to be subject to their own masters in everything, to be pleasing, not contradicting,
		¹⁰ not pilfering, but demonstrating all good faith so that they will adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in everything.

1 - Does your character at work "adorn the doctrine of God our savior"? How do you need to grow in this?
