The Equipping Class meets in the gym at 9:00 AM on Sunday. Kids Ministry and Student Ministry is available at this time as well.

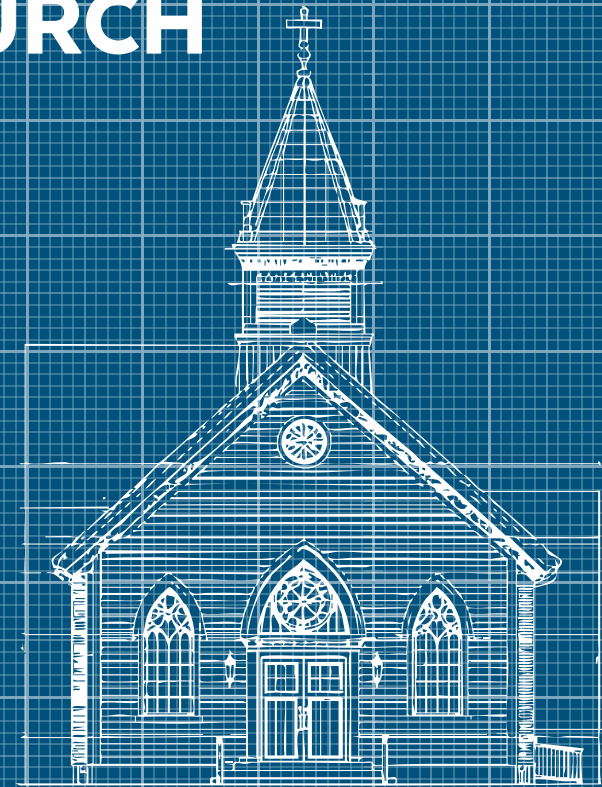
