The Equipping Class meets in the gym at 9:00 AM on Sunday. Kids Ministry and Student Ministry is available at this time as well.



- 3 How would you explain **REGENERATION**? Use verses. Why is this an important doctrine?
- 4 How would you explain **JUSTIFICATION**? Use verses. How does this doctrine affect our daily walk with the Lord?
- 5 **Read Titus 2:1–3:2**. How can you be proactive in the good works (3:8) with both the church and the world? How has your view of church changed since we started studying Titus?
- 6 In a passage like this, there is need for some reflection to make sure you have been born again. If you see no signs of spiritual life in your heart, be sure to talk to a pastor or a fellowship group leader.
