FELLOWSHIP GROUP QUESTIONS

1 - What stood out to you from our study of **Luke 11:3-4**?

2 - **Read Luke 11:3**. How have you seen God's provision in your life? Do you view God as the provider of all your basic needs? What would be good evidence that you view Him as your provider?

3 - Read **Proverbs 30:8-9, Luke 11:2, and James 4:2-3**. How do these verses shape the way we make our request to God? How do they guard against wrong thinking in this area?

4 - **Read Luke 11:4, Psalm 86:5, and 1 John 1:8-9**. Why is asking for forgiveness of sins important for the believer if Christ has already forgiven all their sin? What are the dangers of not confessing our sin?

5 - Read **Colossians 1:9-10, Philippians 1:9-11, and Luke 11:4**. What are ways you need to ask God for help in your holiness? What are ways you can pray for the holiness of your church family or fellowship group?

6 - As believers, we need to pray regularly (**Col 4:2, 1 Thess 5:17**). How is your prayer life? What steps do you need to take to pray more consistently and to pray about the things Jesus calls us to pray about?
