APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1 – In what ways are you thankful for the work of the Lord as we celebrate one year as a church family?

2 – Why is it important that **Christian obedience** (the imperatives) is driven by **divine truth** (the indicatives)? Between doctrine and obedience, which of the two are you more likely to deemphasize? What is the danger in not prioritizing both?

3 – How does Paul's view of the WHAT and WHY of the church differ from the way most people understand the church? How should Paul's view affect your life?

4 – **Read Ephesians 1:3**. Do you view yourself as someone who has been blessed with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ?

FROM January 25th SERMON

1 – **Read Colossians 4:2-3 and Ephesians 6:18-19**. Why do we need to pray for boldness in making the gospel clear? What verses could you use to talk about God, sin, Christ, and responding the Gospel message?

2 – **Read Matthew 9:36-38**. How does this verse give us confidence to pray for more workers? Where are those workers going to come from in Long Beach? Where will they come from in our own church?

3 – **Read 1 Timothy 2:1-5 and Mark 2:5**. Who do you need to be praying for? Make a list of 3-5 people who need to be saved. Pray for them. Plan on praying for them in your fellowship group this week.
