APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1 - What stood out to you from our study of **Ephesians 1:11-12**?

2 - Read **Exodus 19:4-5**, **Luke 15:7**, **Zephaniah 3:17**, and **Deuteronomy 4:20**. What does each of these verses reveal about God's view of His redeemed people? Does this align with the way people usually view God?

3 - If you have trusted in Christ, you are God's prized inheritance. Do you view yourself this way? Do you view your church family this way? **List three ways** this perspective would change your life.

4 - Read **Psalm 115:3**, **Daniel 2:21**, **Genesis 50:20**, **Ephesians 1:11**, and **Acts 4:27-28**. What does each verse tell us about God's sovereignty? How does **Matthew 6:25-34** provide the right response to these realities?

5 - God saves His people "to the praise of His glory." A month ago, we discussed praying "Hallowed be Your name" (Luke 11:2). How often do you pray for God's glory first? Why is this a challenge?

6- **Read Ephesians 1:11-12**. These verses spell out the certainty of our future as God's inheritance. How often do you rejoice in the certainty of your future? Do you have reasons that keep you from rejoicing?
