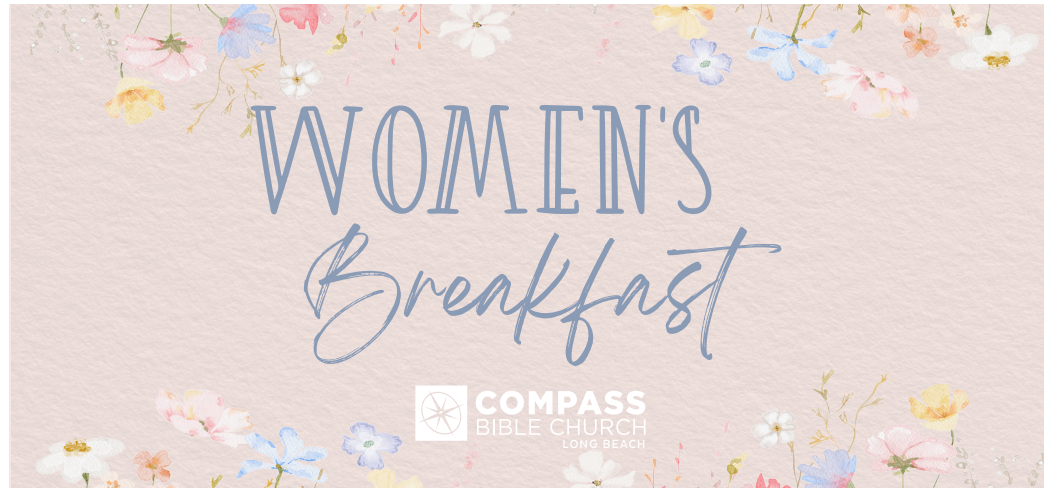

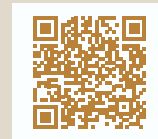
Please remember to be a good witness in the neighborhood around Bancroft Middle School. Each Sunday be sure your car is not blocking anyone's driveway.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1 - What stood out to you from our study of **Ephesians 1:13-14**?

2 - Read **John 3:1-8, Ephesians 5:18, Romans 8:12-14, and Galatians 5:16-24**. What do these verses tell us about the work of the Spirit in the life of the believer?

3 - How does Ephesians 1:13 instruct our understanding of Christian assurance? What other verses address this topic? Why is this such an important topic to understand?

4 - Read **1 John 3:2-3, Colossians 3:1-4, and Romans 8:29-30**. What do these verses say about the life of the believer? How should this affect our present reality?

5 - Read **Ephesians 1:3-14**. How have you been encouraged by our study of every spiritual blessing the believer possesses? How have your thinking or your actions changed?

Questions from Sermon on February 22nd - Secured for His Glory

1 - Read **Exodus 19:4-5, Luke 15:7, Zephaniah 3:17, and Deuteronomy 4:20**. What do each of these verses reveal about God's view of His redeemed people? Does this align with the way people usually view God?

2 - If you have trusted in Christ, you are God's prized inheritance. Do you view yourself this way? Do you view your church family this way? **List three ways** this perspective would change your life.
