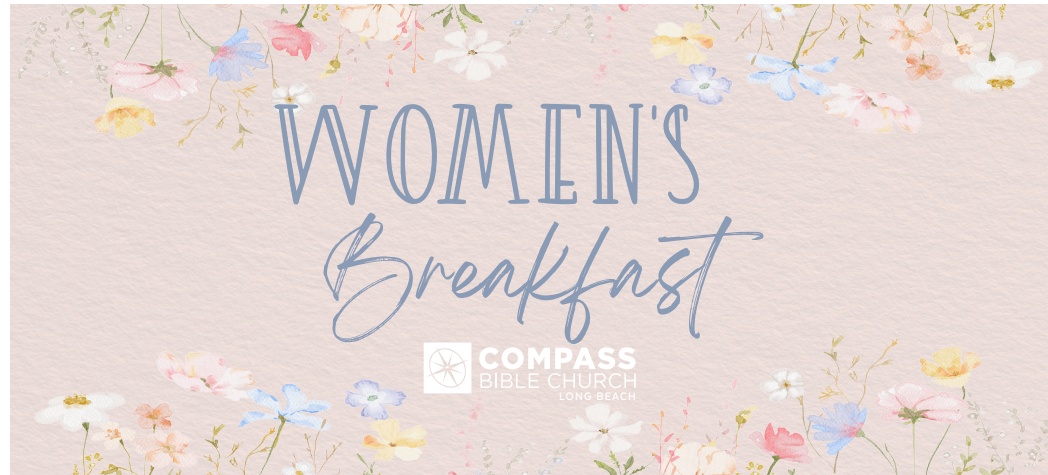

¹⁸so that you—the eyes of your heart having been enlightened—will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,

¹⁹and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe according to the working of the might of His strength,

²⁰which He worked in Christ, by raising Him from the dead and seating Him at His right hand in the heavenly places,

²¹far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come.

²²And He put all things in subjection under His feet, and gave Him as head over all things to the church,

²³which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1 - What stood out to you in our study of **Ephesians 1:18-23**?

2 - Are you hopeful? Spend time considering what the person who knows “the hope of His calling” looks like. Of the three D’s –distraction, discouragement, doubt—which of them keeps you from living like a person whose hope is fixed on heaven?

3 - **Read 1 Peter 2:9-10, Revelation 7:9-10, Revelation 21:1-7.** Those who have trusted in Christ are God’s people and His inheritance. Why are we tempted to envy the world (Psalm 73) when our position is so glorious? How would your life look different if you viewed your position rightly?

4 [Personal] - **Read Ephesians 4:1, 4:17-20, and 5:3.** Are there any secret sins you’ve been protecting that are not fitting for those who are God’s inheritance? God is gracious to forgive, but sins that are unconfessed and unrepented of will go unforgiven. Your elders and church family pray for the blessing of repentance. **Read 1 John 1:8-22 and Proverbs 28:13.**

5 - **Read 2 Peter 1:3-4 and Ephesians 1:19-23** to find descriptions of God’s power toward us. Where do we see descriptions of God’s power in the Bible? What affect does it have in your life knowing this power is always active in the life of the believer?

Summary of Ephesians 1: If you’re a Christian, you’re the richest person in the world. Is that your attitude toward life?

From Last Week: How are things going with the person/people you were specifically inviting to Good Friday or Resurrection Sunday? Any updates or further prayer requests?
