Context: The power of God (1:19-23) and the state of sinners (2:1-3)

APPLICATION QUESTIONS (NO FELLOWSHIP GROUPS THIS WEEK)

1 - What stood out to you in our study of **Ephesians 2:4-7**?

2 - How does this passage prove that salvation is only by God’s mercy and grace? Has this been how you approach your relationship with God? **Read Luke 18:9-14.**

3 - **Read Ephesians 2:1-10.** The testimony Paul provides describes the Christian before grace, saved by grace, and changed by grace. Is your life currently described by v.1-3 or v.4-10?

If v.4-10, when did God make you alive in Christ? How did He move to cause you to respond to the gospel?

If v.1-3, what are you going to do about it? Besides the Lord, who do you need to connect with to discuss this problem?
