APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1 - What stood out to you in our study of **Ephesians 2:8-10**? What does this passage teach us about God?

2 - Our passage talks about grace, faith, and works. How do these three work together? What are different ways people confuse the relationship between faith and works?

3 - **Compare Galatians 6:14 and Romans 3:27**. What are the two types of boasting? How can Christians be tempted to boast in their own works?

4 - What are the good works God has prepared for you? Are you looking at these works with the right attitude?

5 - The testimony Paul provides describes the Christian before grace, saved by grace, and changed by grace. Map out your own testimony. How have you experienced the grace of God?
