¹⁹So then you are no longer strangers and sojourners, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God's household,

²⁰having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner stone, ²¹in whom the whole building, being joined together, is growing into a holy sanctuary in the Lord,

²²in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1 - **Read Ephesians 2:11-22.** How does Paul's view of the church correct common misconceptions held by the culture? How did the last two weeks shape your understanding of the church?

2 - The church is filled with citizens and family members (v.19). Why might Paul want these Gentile readers to be informed of these realities?

3 - How does being citizens with the saints and being members of God's household shape our gatherings? Are you viewing the people of your church rightly?

4 - **Read Jude 3.** What is the importance of the Word in the unity of the church? How central is the Word in your own life, and what might be the effects if it isn't central?

5 - **Read Ephesians 2:21-22** as a group. What is this verse saying about the church? How should these verses shape your expectations for your church and your fellowship group?
