¹For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus on behalf of you Gentiles— ²if indeed you heard of the stewardship of God’s grace which was given to me for you; ³that by revelation there was made known to me the mystery, as I wrote before in brief. ⁴About which, when you read you can understand my insight into the mystery of Christ, ⁵which in other generations was not made known to the sons of men, as it was now revealed to His holy apostles and prophets in the Spirit: ⁶that the Gentiles are fellow heirs and fellow members of the body, and fellow partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel, ⁷of which I was made a minister, according to the gift of God’s grace which was given to me according to the working of His power.

⁸To me, the very least of all saints, this grace was given, to proclaim to the Gentiles the good news of the unfathomable riches of Christ, ⁹and to bring to light for all what is the administration of the mystery which for ages has been hidden in God who created all things; ¹⁰so that the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known through the church to the rulers and the authorities in the heavenly places.

¹¹This was in accordance with the eternal purpose which He carried out in Christ Jesus our Lord, ¹²in whom we have boldness and confident access through faith in Him. ¹³Therefore I ask you not to lose heart at my afflictions on your behalf, which are your glory.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1 - What stood out to you from our study of **Ephesians 3:1-13**?

2 - Do people usually view God as an enthusiastic evangelist? What changes would you make if you regularly expected God to save more people?

3 - Why is it dangerous to view others or yourself as second-class Christians? Are there any ways in which you are lacking in maturity that you have chalked up to being lesser than other Christians?

4 - What are reasons you might be nervous about the current state of the church of Jesus Christ? What passages make you hopeful about the church's future?

5 - **Working Ahead:** Read Ephesians 3:1-13. This time, make note of any lessons that can be gathered from Paul's thoughts regarding his own ministry.
