¹For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus on behalf of you Gentiles— ²if indeed you heard of the stewardship of God’s grace which was given to me for you; ³that by revelation there was made known to me the mystery, as I wrote before in brief. ⁴About which, when you read you can understand my insight into the mystery of Christ, ⁵which in other generations was not made known to the sons of men, as it was now revealed to His holy apostles and prophets in the Spirit: ⁶that the Gentiles are fellow heirs and fellow members of the body, and fellow partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel, ⁷of which I was made a minister, according to the gift of God’s grace which was given to me according to the working of His power.

⁸To me, the very least of all saints, this grace was given, to proclaim to the Gentiles the good news of the unfathomable riches of Christ, ⁹and to bring to light for all what is the administration of the mystery which for ages has been hidden in God who created all things; ¹⁰so that the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known through the church to the rulers and the authorities in the heavenly places.

¹¹This was in accordance with the eternal purpose which He carried out in Christ Jesus our Lord, ¹²in whom we have boldness and confident access through faith in Him. ¹³Therefore I ask you not to lose heart at my afflictions on your behalf, which are your glory.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1 - Read **Ephesians 3:1-13**. What do you find most encouraging about Paul's perspective of his ministry?

2 - How does this passage compel you to either begin serving or keep serving?

3 - What are signs that you've made ministry about yourself and not about serving others?

4 - How does your ministry provide an opportunity for you to make much of Christ?

5 - In light of this study, what are specific ways others can pray for you to be a faithful servant of the Lord Jesus Christ?
