²²And He was passing through from one city and village to another, teaching, and proceeding on His way to Jerusalem.

²³And someone said to Him, "Lord, are there just a few who are being saved?" And He said to them,

²⁴"Strive to enter through the narrow door, for many, I tell you, will seek to enter and will not be able.

²⁵"Once the head of the house gets up and shuts the door, and you begin to stand outside and knock on the door, saying, 'Lord, open up to us!' then He will answer and say to you, 'I do not know where you are from.'

²⁶"Then you will begin to say, 'We ate and drank in Your presence, and You taught in our streets.'

²⁷"And He will say, 'I tell you, I do not know where you are from; depart from Me, all you workers of unrighteousness.'

²⁸"In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God, but yourselves being cast out.

²⁹"And they will come from east and west and from north and south, and will recline at the table in the kingdom of God.

³⁰"And behold, some are last who will be first and some are first who will be last."

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. Why is a sense of urgency important both in giving and receiving the gospel? What changes can you and/or the church family make to reflect a more urgent perspective?

2. What are common causes of false assurance of salvation? (List as many as you can) How would you approach someone you think has a false assurance?

3. How can we stay true to Christ and His message while balancing the fact that the door is narrow but still open? What extremes do we need to avoid?

4. What would it practically look like to strive to enter the narrow door? (List as many ways that might be involved as you can think of) Can you describe what that looked like in your own life?

Spend time praying that we as individuals and as a church would rightly represent Jesus' life and message.
