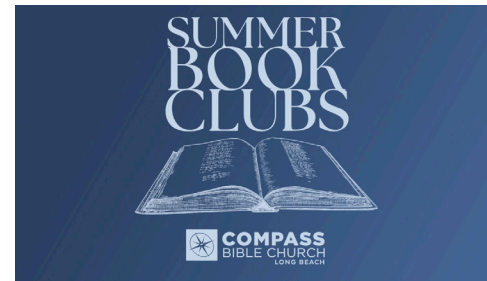


SIGN UP

## APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1 - This sermon completed the first half of our study of Ephesians. We have learned about:

- Possessing every spiritual blessing 1:3-14
- Paul's prayer for knowledge 1:15-23
- The miracle of conversion 2:1-10
- The mystery of a united people 2:11-3:13
- Paul's prayer to live out our faith 3:14-21

How has the Lord used Ephesians to impact your life during this study?

2 - What does this passage teach us about the power of the God in the life of the church? How do you need His power for both Christian living and service in this season?

3 - **Read Psalm 115:1** and **Philippians 1:20**. Are you focused on God's glory in your prayer life? What are the competitors that would keep us from focusing on God's glory, and how do we reorient our hearts back to making life about Him?

4 - **Read Psalm 116:1-2** and **Psalm 5:3**. How would your prayer list and prayer time look different if you perfectly believed that God heard your prayers?

5 - What is your current prayer schedule? How can you be more devoted to prayer this summer? Be specific about your plan in both the timing and the content of your prayers.

Take time in group to pray for your own Christian walk and for our church.
