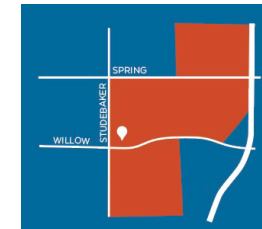

#1 — _____ v.21-24

²⁰Then the mother of the sons of Zebedee came to Him with her sons, bowing down and making a request of Him.

²¹And He said to her, "What do you wish?" She said to Him, "Command that in Your kingdom these two sons of mine may sit one on Your right and one on Your left."

²²But Jesus answered and said, "You do not know what you are asking. Are you able to drink the cup that I am about to drink?" They said to Him, "We are able."

²³He said to them, "My cup you shall drink; but to sit on My right and on My left, this is not Mine to give, but it is for those for whom it has been prepared by My Father."

#2 — _____ v.25-27

²⁴And hearing this, the ten became indignant with the two brothers.

²⁵But Jesus called them to Himself and said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great men exercise authority over them.

#3 — _____ v.28

²⁶"It is not this way among you, but whoever wishes to become great among you shall be your servant,

²⁷and whoever wishes to be first among you shall be your slave;

²⁸just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

APPLICATION QUESTIONS (NO FELLOWSHIP GROUPS UNTIL AUGUST)

1 - What stood out to you in our study of **Matthew 20:20-28**?

2 - How does the world's view of greatness differ from Jesus' description?

3 - Because the world regularly commends ungodly greatness, are there people you can encourage for their service this week? Be sure to send a text, make a phone call, or write a letter to encourage someone.

4 - In what ways are you tempted to focus on status, strength, and success instead of service? Why is it hard to cultivate a servant's heart?

5 - **Read 2 Samuel 23:1-4.** What areas of life have you been given authority (ex: home, work, school, etc)? What does it look to use that authority for the flourishing of others? Are there changes you need to make to be this kind of a blessing?

6 - **Read Matthew 20:28** and **Mark 10:45.** Consider how Jesus served His people. How does His service shape our service in both scope and longevity?
